

What do the new criteria for buy-outs of private land consist of?

- i. Residences within approximately 200 metres of the transmission line outside of the Transportation / Utility Corridor; or
- ii. Parcels bordered on two sides by the transmission line; or
- iii. Businesses subject to significant potential impact due to the transmission line; or
- iv. Multiple residences within the same yard site, where one is within approximately 200m, all are considered for buy-out; or
- v. Multiple transmission facilities including terminal station uniquely impacting a single quarter section with residence.
